### ALITALIA INAUGURATES THE “LE NAVI” VIP LOUNGE AT ROME FIUMICINO AIRPORT

Rome, 30 September 2009 - Alitalia held the Grand Opening of its “Le Navi” VIP lounge located at Rome Fiumicino Terminal C today; the lounge has been completely renovated to welcome Freccia Alata Club members, Magnifica and Business passengers, SkyTeam Elite Plus members, travelling towards extra-Schengen destinations.

The refurbishment is part of a plan to redesign all the airport lounges for Alitalia’s frequent travellers; this project has already seen the complete refurbishment of the *Alfieri* lounge at Turin airport, of the *Bellini* at Catania airport, of the *Bramante* and *Canova* at Rome Fiumicino airport and of the *Parini* and *Manzoni* at Milan Linate airport. By the end of the year, two further international lounges – *Borromini* and *Giotto* – will be refurbished at Rome Fiumicino; the renovation of even more lounges will continue next year.

The *Le Navi* lounge, located at Terminal C, is on two levels and occupies an area of approximately 300sqm. Amongst the amenities offered to the clients are: comfortable leather armchairs, showers, national and international newspapers. Customers will receive personalized service and can use the check-in facilities in the lounge. Clients can take advantage of an exclusive work area offering comfortable seating or relax enjoying refreshments and drinks from the bar.

The overall ambience is elegant and bright, with a colour palette that makes the most of cream and light nuances. A feature plate glass window overlooks the runways at Fiumicino airport.
